Students will work in small teams to identify and interview **upstanders\*** in diverse communities throughout the Seattle area. Each team will create a plan to share the story of an upstander and will see their projects to completion.

*\*Upstander - A person who sees wrong and acts. A person who takes a stand against an act of injustice or intolerance.*
