Participants will explore topics related to Holocaust history, including antisemitism, rescue and resistance, genocide, non-Jewish victims of the Holocaust, Japanese Internment, current events, and local connections. Each day will focus on selected themes and will include reference and discussion of today's world and practical applications for the classroom. Teachers will spend time working together in small groups to develop and prepare lessons for their classrooms.

Participants who complete the program will become the fourth cohort of **Powell Fellows** and will have the opportunity to participate in advanced professional development opportunities throughout the year.

#### **Requirements:**

- Eligible teachers will currently be teaching grades 6-12 in a classroom.
- In the year following the seminar, Powell Fellows will be responsible for incorporating at least one local Holocaust story into their lessons or curriculum
- Fellows will be responsible for communicating with the Holocaust Center on a regular basis.

Participation Fee—\$100 due upon acceptance to the program. (\$50 will be returned upon attendance.)
